SUPERSTERRE CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Our Supersterre program is running at full capacity, and we are very excited at the privilege to be able to make an impact on these precious children's lives and circumstances.

We are astonished by the growth and development of these children even though they only attend this program once a week. The more hands-on

approach of the Tannie-Mammas and the lesser number of children (2-3 kids per adult) makes it a more approachable learning and teachable atmosphere and environment. The children are flourishing in the abundance of love and encouragement that they receive in this program.

This term, besides the teaching of biblical scripture and values through interactive teachings and demonstrations, our focus is mainly on colours and shapes during activity time. Most of the children still struggle to recognize their basic colours and shapes and will be focused on next term.

SUPERSTERRE ECD

The Ma's vir Wellington ECD team are proud to announce that we are registered at DSD. The process could not have been done without the help and support from Inceba and the Vangasali Project.

This term we focused on training and equipping the assistant teachers who volunteer at the school.

Amazing Brainz gave us the opportunity to train 4 more assistant. These assistants had their first practical class and evaluation, and passed with flying colours. In addition to this, we had a Trauma sensitive Classroom workshop at Learn2Live.

Term 2 is evaluation time. The teachers focus on the specific developmental areas and weekly observations are done with each child to track program specific outcomes. We could establish that many children struggle with basic puzzles and fine motor skills.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

This term we also had the privilege to assist families in crisis and need not involved in our programs.

Out the bowl Africa sponsored two "potjiekos" cast iron pots. We were able to feed 200 people of our beneficiaries and some other community members.
