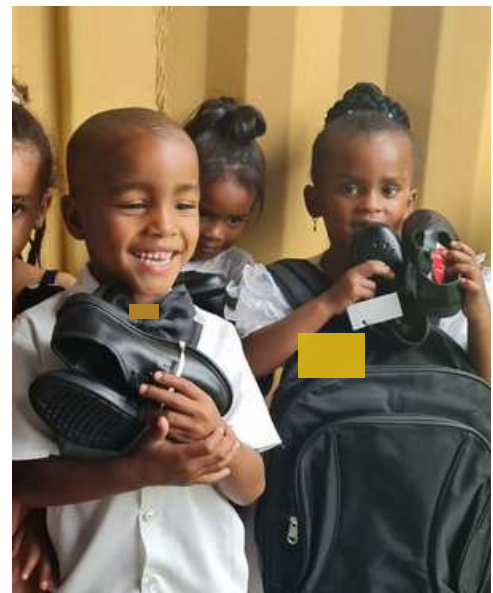

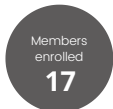


FINDING A PLACE TO BELONG
