- To safeguard and promote their overall wellbeing by doing home visits, providing basic first aid and by reporting abuse and neglect
- To reduce malnourishment and neglect by providing healthy meals and physical need support for children.

Project Objectives

- Mentoring members in biblical values to build their character.
- Three times per week creativity sessions where members can enjoy themselves and develop their own creative skills in order to reach their full potential and social skills.
- Supporting parents in their challenge to care for their disabled children by connecting them with other organisations in the Wellington- /Paarl area.



WOMEN'S MINISTRY

Project Goals

To equip and support women in the community so they can reach out to children in need of love and support.

- To build relationship with caregivers (“tannie-mammas”) to be able to make wise decisions in caring for young children in their care and in their community.
- To train, equip and mentor caregivers with educational, social and emotional support skills
- To facilitate bi-annual introduction programmes for new caregivers

- To equip women to operate as “lighthouses” (places of safety) for our children

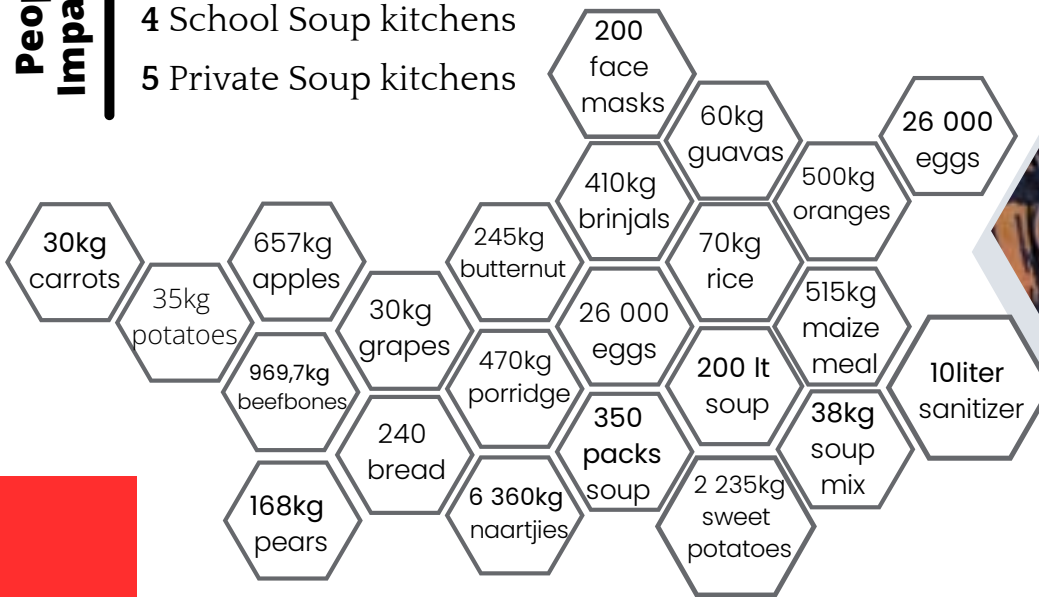

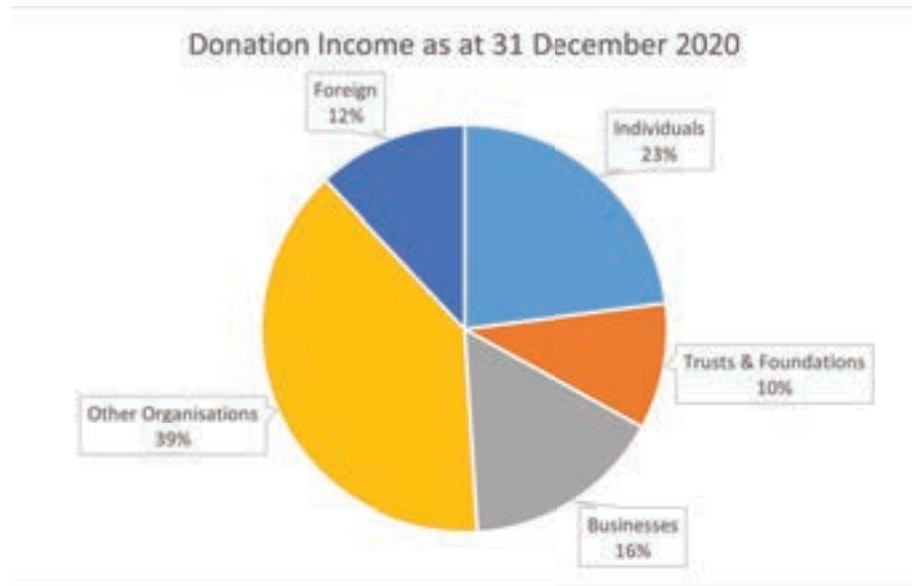
IMPACT 2020

- 209 Families



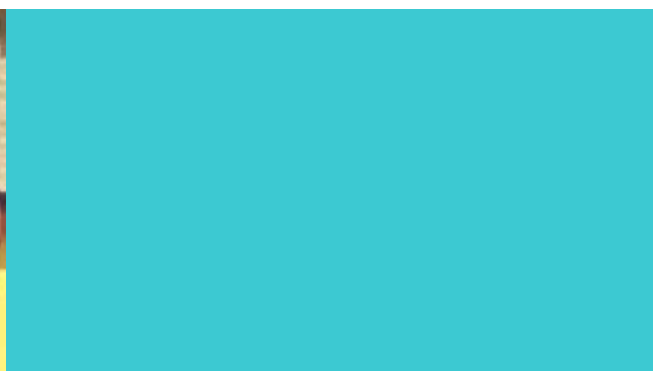
- ⬡ A successful audit of the Annual Financial Statements for the year ended 30 June 2020.
